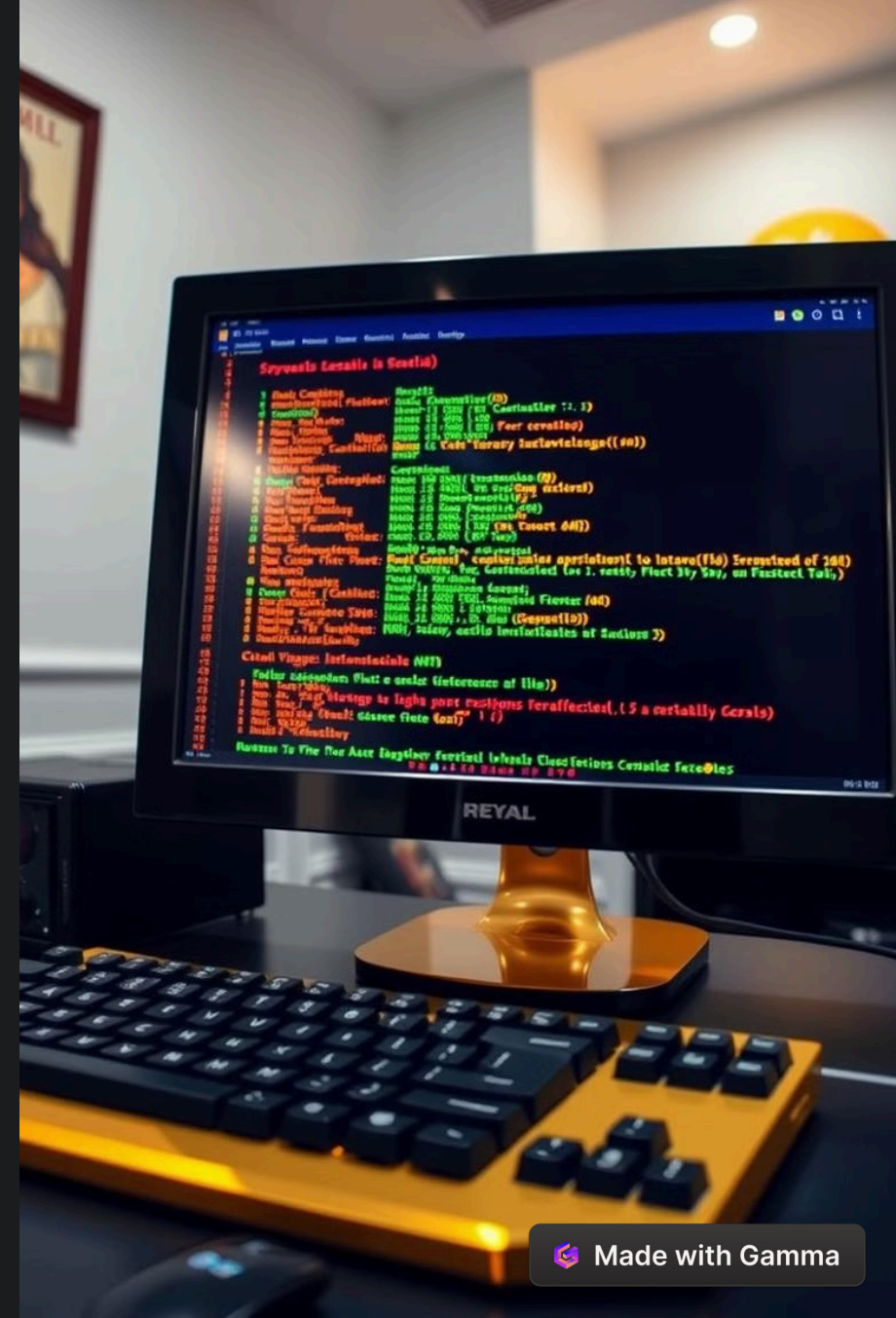


# Hello, World! Your First Python Program

# The Print Function

## What is it?

The **print()** function is your tool for displaying output. It's the foundation of any Python program that communicates with the user.

## How to Use It

Simply type **print()** followed by the text you want to display in parentheses, enclosed in quotation marks. For example:  
**print("Hello, World!").**

## Save Your Code

Save your Python code as a file with a .py extension, like "hello.py".

## Open a Terminal

Use a terminal or command prompt and navigate to the directory where you saved the file.

Type **python hello.py** and press Enter to run your program.
